CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OFFICE

This Conflict of Interest Code is promulgated under the authority of the Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000 et seq., which requires all state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. Section 18730 of 2 California Code of Regulations, as adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which may be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act.

Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendix in which employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Registrar of Voters Office.

Designated employees, other than the Registrar of Voters, shall file their Statements of Economic Interests with the Secretary of the Registrar of Voters Office who will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction (Government Code Section 81008). The original Statement of Economic Interest of the Registrar of Voters shall be forwarded to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and a copy shall be retained by the Secretary of the Registrar of Voters Office.
